THIS CHAIN, AND THE FORTIFICATIONS AROUND IT, HELPED SECURE THE HUDSON VALLEY AND PLAYED A VITAL ROLE IN THE AMERICAN VICTORY.

ESTABLISHMENT AS A MILITARY POST

BY 1778, WEST POINT HAD BECOME THE SITE OF A PERMANENT MILITARY POST. THE FORTIFICATIONS CONSTRUCTED HERE WERE SOME OF THE MOST FORMIDABLE OF THEIR TIME, AND WEST POINT QUICKLY GAINED A REPUTATION AS THE "GIBRALTAR OF THE HUDSON." IT WAS ALSO HERE THAT BENEDICT ARNOLD, THE INFAMOUS AMERICAN GENERAL TURNED TRAITOR, ATTEMPTED TO HAND OVER THE FORT TO THE BRITISH, AN EPISODE THAT REMAINS A DRAMATIC CHAPTER IN THE HISTORY OF WEST POINT.

FOUNDING OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY

IT WASN'T UNTIL 1802 THAT WEST POINT TRANSITIONED FROM A MERE MILITARY POST INTO THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY. PRESIDENT THOMAS JEFFERSON SIGNED THE ACT ESTABLISHING THE ACADEMY, MAKING IT THE FIRST INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE UNITED STATES DEDICATED TO ENGINEERING AND MILITARY SCIENCE.

THE VISION BEHIND THE ACADEMY

JEFFERSON'S VISION FOR WEST POINT WAS TO CREATE A PROFESSIONAL OFFICER CORPS FOR THE YOUNG AMERICAN REPUBLIC. AT THE TIME, MOST MILITARY OFFICERS HAD BEEN TRAINED IN EUROPE, BUT JEFFERSON BELIEVED IN CULTIVATING AMERICAN TALENT AT HOME. THE CURRICULUM WAS HEAVILY FOCUSED ON ENGINEERING, MATHEMATICS, AND THE SCIENCES — ESSENTIAL SKILLS FOR BUILDING FORTIFICATIONS, ROADS, AND OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE CRITICAL TO NATIONAL DEFENSE.

EARLY YEARS AND CURRICULUM

THE EARLY CADETS AT WEST POINT UNDERWENT RIGOROUS TRAINING THAT COMBINED ACADEMIC STUDY WITH MILITARY DISCIPLINE.
