### THE GOLDEN AGE OF ATHENS UNDER PERICLES

## PERICLES' ROLE IN ATHENIAN IMPERIALISM AND THE DELIAN LEAGUE

PERICLES ALSO PLAYED A PIVOTAL ROLE IN EXPANDING ATHENS' POWER BEYOND ITS BORDERS. AFTER THE PERSIAN WARS, ATHENS BECAME THE LEADER OF THE DELIAN LEAGUE, A COALITION INITIALLY FORMED TO DEFEND AGAINST PERSIAN AGGRESSION.

#### TRANSFORMATION OF THE DELIAN LEAGUE

Under Pericles, the Delian League gradually evolved from a defensive alliance into an Athenian empire. Member states contributed funds and ships, which Athens used to strengthen its navy and finance public works. This centralization of power allowed Athens to dominate the Aegean Sea and exert considerable influence over other Greek city-states.

### MILITARY CAMPAIGNS AND CONFLICTS

2015-11-11 Pericles, the Athenian political leader and general was noted for his oratory, political acumen, and integrity. He was instrumental in strengthening and extending the Athenian Empire. He originated a major building programme, of which the jewel was the Parthenon, the temple that dominated the acropolis. When the spectre of war with the Peloponnesians threatened in the 430s, Pericles determined to resist their demands. After the Peloponnesian War broke out, he persuaded the Athenians to abandon the countryside when the Spartans invaded and to rely on their fleet. He was briefly deposed from the generalship when plague shattered Athenian confidence, but was re-elected the following year. He died of plague soon afterwards. In expanding Pericles' biography, modern historians consider this Athenian statesman as being largely responsible for the full development of Athens, of both the Athenian democracy and the Athenian Empire, making Athens the political and cultural focus of Greece.
