TIPS FOR LEARNING THE CYRILLIC ALPHABET:

- USE FLASHCARDS TO MEMORIZE LETTER SHAPES AND SOUNDS.
- PRACTICE WRITING EACH LETTER BY HAND TO REINFORCE MEMORY.

CASES AND THEIR IMPORTANCE

RUSSIAN USES SIX MAIN CASES (NOMINATIVE, GENITIVE, DATIVE, ACCUSATIVE, INSTRUMENTAL, AND PREPOSITIONAL), WHICH AFFECT THE ENDINGS OF NOUNS, PRONOUNS, AND ADJECTIVES. THIS SYSTEM MIGHT FEEL OVERWHELMING, BUT LEARNING CASES GRADUALLY—STARTING WITH THE NOMINATIVE AND ACCUSATIVE—WILL HELP YOU UNDERSTAND SENTENCE STRUCTURE AND MEANING.

VERB CONJUGATIONS AND ASPECTS

VERBS IN RUSSIAN ARE CONJUGATED ACCORDING TO PERSON AND NUMBER, SIMILAR TO ENGLISH, BUT THEY ALSO HAVE TWO ASPECTS: PERFECTIVE AND IMPERFECTIVE. THE ASPECT SHOWS WHETHER AN ACTION IS COMPLETED OR ONGOING, WHICH IS ESSENTIAL FOR EXPRESSING TIME AND INTENT CLEARLY.
