Drone bees grow into adult bees in 24 days, whereas worker bees need 18 to 22 days to reach full development. Conclusion The pollination process is mostly made possible by honey bees. When pollinating, honey bees may fly at a speed of around 20 mph, while returning to the beehive with nectar they have collected at a speed of about 17 mph.
