PATIENT RESPONSE AND EVALUATION

TIMELINESS

DOCUMENTATION SHOULD BE COMPLETED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER THE ASSESSMENT TO ENSURE DETAILS ARE FRESH AND TO ALLOW PROMPT CLINICAL DECISIONS. DELAYED NOTES CAN OMIT CRUCIAL INFORMATION OR LEAD TO DISCREPANCIES IN PATIENT CARE RECORDS.
