BABY-PROOFING YOUR HOME

AS BABIES GROW INTO CURIOUS TODDLERS, THEIR EXPLORATION INSTINCTS KICK IN. PARENTS NEED TO:

Secure sharp objects, cleaning supplies, and medications out of reach.

- INSTALL SAFETY GATES AT STAIRS AND USE OUTLIET COVERS.
- ENSURE FURNITURE IS STABLE AND FREE FROM SHARP EDGES.
- KEEP CHOKING HAZARDS SUCH AS SMALL TOYS OR FOOD PIECES AWAY.

SIMPLE STEPS LIKE THESE HELP PREVENT ACCIDENTS AND GIVE PARENTS PEACE OF MIND.

SAFE SLEEP PRACTICES

SUDDEN INFANT DEATH SYNDROME (SIDS) IS A SIGNIFICANT CONCERN FOR NEW PARENTS. COMMON SENSE BABY CARE INCLUDES FOLLOWING SAFE SLEEP GUIDELINES:

- ALWAYS PLACE BABIES ON THEIR BACKS TO SLEEP.
- Use a firm mattress with a fitted sheet and avoid loose bedding or stuffed toys in the CRIB.
- KEEP THE SLEEP AREA SMOKE-FREE AND AT A COMFORTABLE TEMPERATURE.

THESE PRACTICES DRASTICALLY REDUCE THE RISK OF SLEEP-RELATED INCIDENTS.

- READING TO YOUR CHILD REGULARLY TO BUILD LANGUAGE SKILLS.
- ENGAGING IN INTERACTIVE PLAY THAT PROMOTES PROBLEM-SOLVING AND SOCIAL INTERACTION.

THESE ACTIVITIES SUPPORT BRAIN DEVELOPMENT AND CREATE A STRONG FOUNDATION FOR LIFFLONG LEARNING.

BALANCING ROUTINE AND FLEXIBILITY IN CHILD CARE
