These experiences can sometimes tip the scales in your favor, even if your GPA is borderline.

PERSONAL STATEMENT AND LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

YOUR PERSONAL STATEMENT IS YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO TELL YOUR STORY, EXPLAIN WHY OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY IS YOUR PASSION, AND HIGHLIGHT YOUR UNIQUE STRENGTHS. A COMPELLING, HEARTFELT ESSAY CAN SIGNIFICANTLY BOOST YOUR APPLICATION. ADDITIONALLY, STRONG LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM PROFESSORS, EMPLOYERS, OR CLINICIANS WHO KNOW YOUR WORK ETHIC AND CHARACTER ADD CREDIBILITY. THESE ELEMENTS COMPLEMENT YOUR ACADEMIC RECORD AND EXPERIENCE BY OFFERING INSIGHT INTO YOUR PERSONALITY AND MOTIVATION.

Choose recommenders who know you well and can speak to your academic abilities, character, and suitability for the occupational therapy profession. Provide them with your resume or personal statement draft to help them write detailed, personalized letters.
