- BUDGET CONSTRAINTS: COST CAN BE A LIMITING FACTOR, PARTICULARLY FOR SMALLER MINISTRIES; FREE OR LOW-COST DIGITAL RESOURCES MAY OFFER PRACTICAL ALTERNATIVES.
- ADAPTABILITY: TRAINING THAT ALLOWS CUSTOMIZATION TO LOCAL CULTURE, LANGUAGE, AND YOUTH DEMOGRAPHICS SUPPORTS MORE EFFECTIVE MINISTRY OUTCOMES.

Understanding these factors helps ministry coordinators select materials that not only train leaders but also enhance the overall health and growth of their youth programs.
