HOWEVER, UNLIKE PURELY THEORETICAL SUBJECTS, LEARNING HTML AND CSS DEMANDS AN ACTIVE, ITERATIVE APPROACH. THE BEST WAY TO PRACTICE HTML AND CSS INVOLVES CREATING, TESTING, AND REFINING CODE IN REAL-TIME, WHICH HELPS SOLIDIFY CONCEPTS AND UNCOVER NUANCES THAT STATIC LEARNING CANNOT PROVIDE. ADDITIONALLY, BUILDING PROJECTS INTRODUCES LEARNERS TO COMMON CHALLENGES LIKE CROSS-BROWSER COMPATIBILITY AND ACCESSIBILITY, WHICH ARE CRUCIAL FOR PROFESSIONAL WEB DEVELOPMENT.
