PRACTICES TO CULTIVATE AWARENESS

TO DEEPEN YOUR AWARENESS OF THIS LOVING PRESENCE, CONSIDER:

- PRAYER OR MEDITATION FOCUSED ON GRATITUDE AND OPENNESS
