Finally, Millward weaves into the plot sporting events like the World Cup and the Rumble in the Jungle and the host of excellent films released during the year. *Fast Forward: Music and Politics in 1974* offers a multidimensional interpretation of a momentous year - analytical yet accessible, weighty yet witty - and is the perfect addition to any music-lover's bookcase. It merits the accolade given by Record Collector magazine to its predecessor, *Different Tracks* (Matador, 2014) - 'an incisive, all-inclusive discourse...a sharply-delineated time-capsule'.
