TIPS FOR FACILITATING A MEANINGFUL DISCUSSION

HAVING A LIST OF QUESTIONS IS A GREAT START, BUT HOW YOU GUIDE THE CONVERSATION CAN MAKE ALL THE DIFFERENCE. HERE ARE SOME TIPS TO ENCOURAGE OPEN, THOUGHTFUL DIALOGUE AROUND *SAVE ME A SEAT*:

- ****ENCOURAGE EMPATHY****: PROMPT READERS TO PUT THEMSELVES IN THE CHARACTERS' SHOES. THIS NOT ONLY DEEPENS UNDERSTANDING BUT ALSO DEVELOPS EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE.

FURTHERMORE, THE CULTURAL SPECIFICITY OF THE NOVEL MAY REQUIRE ADDITIONAL CONTEXT FOR SOME READERS UNFAMILIAR WITH SOUTH ASIAN TRADITIONS OR THE AMERICAN SCHOOL SYSTEM. PROVIDING BACKGROUND INFORMATION ALONGSIDE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS CAN ENHANCE COMPREHENSION AND SENSITIVITY.
