HOW TO IDENTIFY A MITE INFESTATION

SIGNS OF DUST MITE ALLERGIES

- PERSISTENT SNEEZING OR RUNNY NOSE
- ITCHY, WATERY EYES
- ASTHMA FLARE-UPS OR DIFFICULTY BREATHING
- ECZEMA OR ITCHY SKIN RASHES

IF THESE SYMPTOMS WORSEN IN BED OR WHEN YOU'RE NEAR SOFT FURNISHINGS, DUST MITES MAY BE THE CULPRIT.

DETECTING SCABIES MITES

- INTENSE ITCHING, ESPECIALLY AT NIGHT
- SMALL, RAISED BUMPS OR BLISTERS ON THE SKIN
- THIN BURROW TRACKS VISIBLE ON THE SKIN SURFACE, COMMONLY BETWEEN FINGERS OR AROUND THE WRISTS

RECOGNIZING MANGE MITES ON PETS

- EXCESSIVE SCRATCHING OR BITING AT THE SKIN

- HAIR LOSS IN PATCHES
- RED, INFLAMED, OR SCALY SKIN

IF YOUR PET SHOWS THESE SIGNS, A VETERINARY VISIT IS ESSENTIAL FOR PROPER DIAGNOSIS.

PRACTICAL WAYS TO GET RID OF MITES AT HOME

ONCE YOU'VE IDENTIFIED THE TYPE OF MITE PROBLEM YOU'RE FACING, THE NEXT STEP IS IMPLEMENTING EFFECTIVE CONTROL MEASURES. HERE'S HOW TO GET RID OF MITES USING BOTH NATURAL AND CONVENTIONAL APPROACHES.

1. CLEANING AND VACUUMING

- Baking soda: Used in combination with vacuuming, baking soda can help absorb moisture and reduce mite populations.
