Jungle Tales of Tarzan is actually a nice companion volume to the original Tarzan of the Apes, provide more depth and detail to the early years of the Lord of the Jungle. It also marks a coda to what we would now consider the original story arc of the Tarzan novels. Burroughs would write another 21 Tarzan novels but they would become increasingly formulaic. In many ways this is the last time we would see the original Tarzan; you can think of Jungle Tales of Tarzan as sort of being the deleted scenes from the original Tarzan of the Apes novel.
