I eventually found the correct weight and BHB rating for a horse based on it's last performances in handicap races. Punter's can be fickle people which 95% of them have no understanding of horse form and probability. If you can back horses at higher prices then you will make money! I regularly back horses that have a starting price of 2/1 and get 10/1! Most punters want winners everyday regardless of the price and the horse's real chance of winning that race, this is where the bookmakers clean up.
